BEFORE YOUR VISIT

Get the Carrier Ready:

- Place your cat's carrier in a neutral, quiet area of your home as soon as possible. Leave it open so your cat can explore it at their own pace. To help them associate it with positive experiences, try placing their favorite treats or food inside the carrier.

Pack Comfort Items:

- Bring along a few of your cat's favorite toys and treats to help keep them calm and comfortable during their visit.

New Patients:

- If this is your cat's first visit with us, feel free to call ahead and request complimentary Zylkene and Feliway to help ease their stress.

Calming Products Available:

- We offer a variety of calming medications and feline pheromone products available for purchase to help make your cat's visit more relaxed.



DURING YOUR VISIT

Enter Through the Cat-Only Lobby:

- Please use our dedicated cat-only entrance for a quieter, more comfortable experience. When you arrive, place your cat's carrier with the door facing away from other animals to help reduce stress.

Warm Pheromone Towels:

- In our cat-only lobby, we offer complimentary warm towels from our towel warmer. These towels are infused with calming feline pheromones and can stay with your cat throughout their visit to provide comfort.

In the Exam Room:

- Once in the cat-only exam room, open the carrier door and allow your cat to come out at their own pace. If your cat is hesitant, a team member will gently assist them in a low-stress manner.

Calming Medication Options:

- If your cat experiences high levels of stress during visits, talk to your veterinarian about calming medications.
